Thank you for choosing Next Step as the school help you to meet your educational goals. We welcome full time students who choose to have Next Step as their primary high school as well as shared students who do most of their courses at another EIPS high school and use Next Step to facilitate courses they need flexibility in taking.

Next Step is a supportive, alternative senior high school for students who require a non-traditional, individualized program. Located in community-based sites in Sherwood Park, Fort Saskatchewan, and Vegreville, Next Step provides students with:

- a safe, comfortable environment
- flexible, individual schedules
- the opportunity to take responsibility for their own education and to experience success

Student Responsibilities

Course Registration and Completion

- Students are required to meet with their teacher to go through a course orientation prior to starting their course.
- Students are able to access their course through BrightSpace and can monitor their achievement though PowerSchool.
- Suggested timelines for assessments are given to students by their teachers at their course orientation.
- Students needing flexibility with their suggested timelines are encouraged to meet with their teacher to discuss a plan to achieve success.

Students are encouraged to attend at their Next Step Campus to meet with their teacher on a regular basis. School staff are available to support students in successfully completing their courses. All assessments are to be completed in person.

Resources

- Textbooks are provided by Next Step. Required books will be discussed with the teacher at the orientation meeting and students will be able to sign books out with school staff after their course enrolment is complete.
- Computer access is available at every Next Step Campus. Students requiring additional access to technology can discuss arrangements with administration.
